Women from all races, communities, and walks of life have made huge contributions to American society. March gives us a chance to celebrate these women and all they've done.

5 WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH FACTS:



- When this celebration first started in 1978, it was a week-long affair that corresponded with **International Women's Day** on March 8.
- In 1987 Congress passed a resolution that designated **the whole month of March** as a celebration of women's history.
- This year's theme— **"Celebrating Women Who Tell Our Stories"**— recognizes women in art and media, from books and blogs to newscasts and podcasts and everything in between.
- **The 19th Amendment** was signed into law in 1919, giving most women the right to vote.
- **Kamala Harris** is the first female Vice President, and this year there are more women in Congress than ever! They make up more than a quarter of its 535 members.



5 PEOPLE YOU SHOULD KNOW:

- **Jovita Idár:** A Mexican-American journalist who advocated for women's rights, including the right to vote, throughout the early 1900s.
- **Maya Angelou:** Writer, poet, and civil rights activist Maya Angelou was most famous for her beloved 1969 autobiography, *I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings*.
- **Gloria Steinem:** A leader in the women's rights movement since the 1960s, Gloria Steinem is a journalist who launched *Ms.* magazine, the first feminist publication in the U.S.
- **Toni Morrison:** Beloved novelist Toni Morrison wrote poetically about the African-American experience, and even won the Nobel Prize for Literature in 1993.
- **Ann Curry:** As a Japanese American journalist, Ann Curry secured a place in broadcasting history with more than two decades of humanitarian reporting from war zones and natural disasters.
